May 5th 2011, SCI helped out local folks who were not as lucky as most of us in escaping the tornados that ravaged the state of Oklahoma.

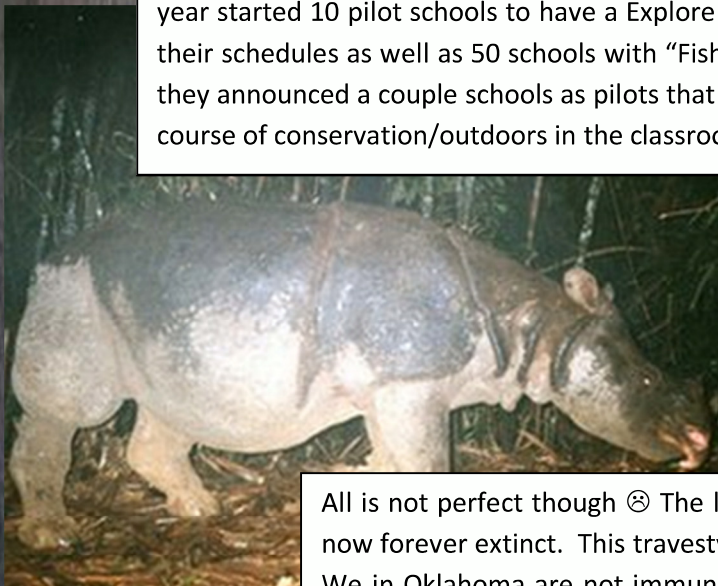


• SCI contributed a total of \$25,000

Oklahoma Station - SCI Supports and Contributes Funds Locally & Nationally

The future of hunting is up to each one of us. It is our financial donations, our efforts in the political arena, and our ability to educate the uninformed public of the important role hunting plays in the welfare of the animal population and their habitat. Our activities and energy must focus on 3 areas - Conservation, Education, and Governmental affairs.

We, the members of SCI, are the last best chance that wildlife has to survive in a healthy habitat, and we have to preserve our right to hunt.

Protect the Freedom to Hunt

FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO PROTECT OUR FREEDOM TO HUNT & WILDLIFE

CONSERVATION PROGRAMS - Thirty percent (30%) of net monies raised by the Oklahoma Station Chapter support programs that provide for full-time staff lobbyists & biologists in Washington, DC. SCI is the only hunting organization that has full-time lobbyists & biologists working to provide sound scientific information to influence legislation and regulations that affect hunting both at the federal and state levels. 70% of funds raised by the Oklahoma Station Chapter are used in Oklahoma for hunting-education, wildlife-conservation and humanitarian-services programs.

Highlights of 2011- 2012

Funded a Operation Game Thief Trailer for the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife – Our chapter committed \$25,000 over 3 years to the ODWC to build a new trailer to be used in the Operation Game Thief program. We received a \$5,000 grant from the SCI foundation to help with this commitment.

We provided the funds to send 4 Oklahoma teachers to the 7 day American Wilderness Leadership School in Jackson Hole Wyoming in 2011. These teachers will now be prepared to take this learning experience and bring it to hundreds of our state youth over the coming years. We will send at least 3 teachers to the 2012 training. The ODWC helps us support this program and contributes the travel cost for 2 teachers each year.

Our chapter agreed to support an additional Shotgun Training Education Program (STEP) replacement trailer. Our commitment is for over \$15,000 to help ODWC purchase a new trailer for this fantastic program.

Our chapter helped fund a youth shooting range at the Oklahoma City Gun Club with a \$1,500 donation.

As a result of our very successful 2011 banquet we were able to provide over \$30,000 to the national SCI organization for conservation and in support of our right to hunt.



Conservation

OKLAHOMA HABITAT DONOR PROGRAM -

- Financial support for the Hackberry Flats Wetlands project, Frederick, OK.
- Financial support for a "Quality Deer Management" program in Lincoln County, OK.
- Financial support for the ODWC black bear collar program

RESTORATION OF RUFFED GROUSE & PRAIRIE CHICKEN - Financial support towards restoration of ruffed grouse and Greater Prairie Chicken habitat in Oklahoma. 2009 support for Audubon Society/OSC conservation project to protect the threatened Lesser Prairie Chicken in Northwest Oklahoma in conjunction with the Lesser Prairie Chicken festival.

INTRODUCED EIGHT (8) ELK INTO THE EXISTING HERD IN SE. OKLAHOMA -

Chapter financed the purchase, transportation and release of 5 mature bred cow elk and 2 mature bulls plus radio-collar transmitters for monitoring purposes. These 8 elk will improve the gene pool in the existing elk herd in SE Oklahoma which is in cooperation with the Timberline Elk Ranch, Cushing, Oklahoma, and the ODWC.

ODWC Contributions – Since the foundation of the Oklahoma Station Chapter of SCI, over \$ 280,000 has been funded for various Wildlife Department programs either through direct funding or purchase of equipment for ODWC use.

Education

SIGNIFICANT FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR YOUTH EDUCATION & OUTDOOR

PROGRAMS – Archery in the Schools program (\$ 9,500 in 2008), Last Frontier Council - Boy Scouts of America; Eddy Eagle Gun Safety program; Make a Wish Foundation, Youth Hunter Education Challenge, & the 4H Youth Shooting Team.

OKLAHOMA DEPT OF WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COLORING BOOKS - We purchased 65,000 wildlife conservation coloring books for school children.

APPRENTICE HUNTER PROGRAM -An annual youth essay writing contest that focuses on America's hunting heritage; co-sponsored by the Okla. Dept of Wildlife Conservation. Two students in the 11-14 age category win scholarships to attend a weeklong program at the YO Ranch in Mountain Home, Texas. One boy and one girl, 15-17, each win a guided pronghorn antelope hunt in New Mexico and presentation of their mounts at the Annual OSC Awards Banquet & Charity Fundraiser.

THE AMERICAN WILDERNESS LEADERSHIP SCHOOL - Each year, our Chapter and the Okla. Dept. of Wildlife Conservation sponsor two Oklahoma educators for an 8-day experience at SCI's Granite Ranch near Jackson, Wyoming, in fields of wildlife ecology, firearm safety and shooting sports, camping, white-water rafting, stream ecology, natural resource management with a base knowledge from which to evaluate conservation efforts. They bring this training back to their classrooms to educate thousands of Oklahoma youth on the value of hunting as a wildlife management tool.

STEP PROGRAM – Okla. Dept of Wildlife Conservation's **Shotgun Training Education Program ("STEP")** – OSC-SCI supported this program by originally purchasing a custom built 26-foot long gooseneck equipment trailer. OSC purchased two additional trailers in 2008. These trailers carry the program's portable trap machines, firearms, ammunition, safety and gun maintenance equipment. In the past 10 years, 100,000 persons in the state



of Oklahoma (65% are youth under the age of 18) have participated in STEP, leaning the importance of hunting as a conservation and management tool and improving their shooting skills to ensure the humane harvesting of wildlife.

OKLAHOMA WILDLIFE EXPO – Our Chapter supports the ODWC - Wildlife Expo with significant funding and with workers. This is the biggest and the most successful comprehensive hands-on outdoor education experience and recreation event in State history. Approximately 60,000 attend annually. In 2011, OSC featured "Predators of Oklahoma" with a game for thousands of youth to identify the animals and win a prize for successfully doing so (all eventually won). We estimate over 8000 kids participated in our "Predators of Oklahoma" game.

WILDLIFE HERITAGE CENTER MUSEUM, ANTLERS, OK. – Our Chapter contributed to the building of the museum/learning center in SE Oklahoma. The operation is a joint agreement of the Okla. Dept of Commerce, Okla. Tourism and Recreation Dept and the Okla. Dept of Wildlife. The facility will be utilized as a regional tourism attraction while at the same time serving as a wildlife and natural resource conservation public education center.

SAFARI IN A BOX - Safari in a Box is a K-12 education kit designed to provide exciting, hands-on learning. It gives teachers and others who work with young people resources and ideas to introduce youth to important concepts of habitat, wildlife management and impacts resulting from human and wildlife interactions. Initial SIB placement was in memory of OSC member David Rocker.

"SCI SAVES CSI" - 2009 support of OSU's "Insect Adventure", a project which teaches basic conservation principles to over 300,000 individuals in Oklahoma each year (and also contributes to the conservation of the endangered American burying beetle, a species valuable in Crime Scene Analysis).

Humanitarian Services

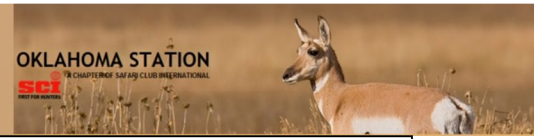
SAFARI-CARE – On numerous occasions, OSC members have traveled internationally and carried medical, educational and relief supplies to villages in need of support.

SPORTSMEN AGAINST HUNGER – OSC originally funded 100% of operating expenses for the program in excess of \$200,000 annual budget. OSC also managed the program State-wide for over 10 years. OSC continues to financially support this program annually, and in 2011 as we have for the past 10 years we supported this program with a \$ 2,000 contribution to ODWC.

SENSORY SAFARI DAY - A hands-on adventure for sightless and sight-impaired children and adults. Members loan their animal mounts for these people to see for the first time, through their fingertips, animals from around the world. The event is co-sponsored by the Okla. Dept. Wildlife Conservation, Oklahoma Station Chapter - SCI and the H&H Gun Range.

VETERANS' HUNTS – OSC organized Mid-East-Conflict veterans' hunts in conjunction with Jay Barczak of Wild Game Outfitters-Duchess Creek Ranch, Porum, OK, and in conjunction with other supporters. In 2009, three veterans were drawn from public nominations for guided elk and deer hunts complete with all accommodations. In 2010, OSC and Mankazana Safaris presented a Purple-Heart veteran the hunt of a lifetime in Africa. OSC supports our troops who protect our freedoms!

Sam Moreton

Forest and Water Ecology, Earth Science and Anaimlas.

Sam is Project WILD and hunter education trained. He has been the coordinator for 12 years for New Life Ranch near Colcord Oklahoma. Currently approximately 40 public, private and Christian school groups come to New Life Ranch for one-

three day outdoor education camps. The size of group ranges from 15-350 students. Students receive training in Astronomy, birding, fire building, fishing, flight, fossils, GPS, wildlife habitat, outdoor edibles, insects, forest ecology etc. while at the camp. Exploring and learning about the outdoors in an outdoor setting is the focus of the day and summer camp activities.



Beverly Stephens

5th-8th Grade
English/Geography/Archery

Beverly teaches the Oklahoma National Archery in Schools program at Greenville School in Marietta. She was also instrumental in helping Turner High School set-up their archery program. Beverly also annually works with the

ODWC to take all 5th-8th grade students through the Department's STEP program allowing many students that have never shot a shotgun before to receive safe firearms training and quality instruction from ODWC staff members.



Craig Savage

9th-12th Grade AFJROTC, Aerospace Science and Financial Literacy

School: Inola High School

Incorporates Archery in Schools, Hunter Education and Explore Bow hunting into his AFJROTC class . Craig is also an NRA certified rifle instructor,

NRA Certified Range Safety Officer, and an assistant coach with the Inola FFA for Skeet and Trap.

Besides teaching wildlife conservation in the classroom, Craig has also worked with the youth during Quail Forever youth day activities. He has promoted wildlife habitat restoration efforts along with Quail Forever during its wildlife conservation days for landowners.

2011 Conservation Education Scholarship

Two educators will be awarded a scholarship to an eight-day conservation education school at Safari Club International's American Wilderness Leadership School (AWLS) at Granite Ranch near Jackson, Wyoming. The AWLS program covers many different aspects of conservation education.

Lodging, meals and training materials will be provided by Oklahoma Station Chapter Safari Club International. Transportation to Jackson, Wyoming, will be covered by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation.

Educator applications are judged in categories such as:

Training in conservation education or environmental education programs.

Current programs you are conducting in your school and community with a conservation and environmental emphasis.

Past programs you have conducted with a conservation and environmental emphasis.

Teachers of state winners in the youth essay contest: Hunting: Sharing the Heritage, will receive priority consideration.

The AWLS program is conducted during the summer. AWLS presents an outdoor program for educators which concentrates on natural resource management and provides participants with a base knowledge from which they may evaluate conservation efforts. Participants learn about stream ecology, map and compass, language arts and creative writing in an outdoor setting, fly tying, shooting sports, wildlife management, the Yellowstone ecosystem, camping, white-water rafting, educational resources and how to implement outdoor education ideas. Six sessions will be offered June through August of 2011.

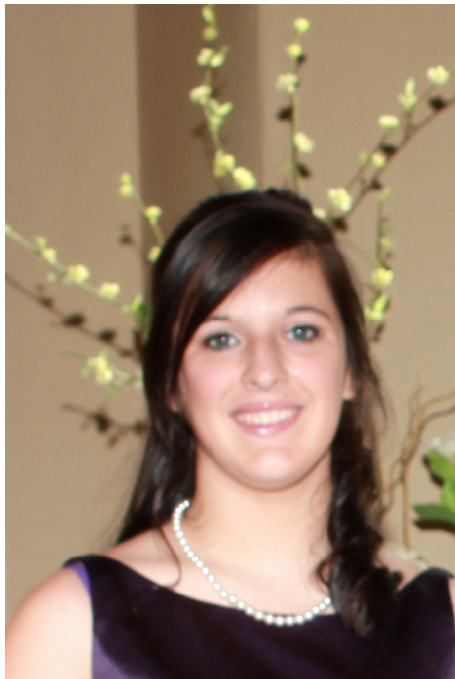

PROCEDURES FOR THE AUCTION

You must register to receive a bid number and participate in the auction and silent auction. You are responsible for the care and use of your bid number.

When bidding from the floor, raise your hand, napkin, or if necessary, stand to get the attention of the auctioneer or one of this staff.

The auctioneer and his staff are responsible for the auction. Their rules must be followed explicitly. All decisions of the auctioneer will be final. "BIRDY" DIRTY RICE

1 cup uncooked long grain
white rice
2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups chicken stock or broth,
divided
4 tablespoons ($\frac{1}{2}$ stick) butter
8 ounces dove breasts (8 to 12),
coarsely chopped

1 cup finely chopped onion
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup finely chopped celery
2 garlic cloves, finely chopped
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon black pepper
 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon cayenne pepper
Chopped green onions

Cook the rice in 2 cups chicken stock for about 20 minutes. Heat the butter in a large skillet and fry the dove until the pink color is gone. Add the onion, celery, garlic, black pepper and cayenne pepper. Sauté for 5 minutes or until the vegetables are softened. Add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup chicken stock and the cooked rice. Cover and simmer over low heat until the liquid is absorbed. Garnish with chopped green onions and serve with hot sauce.

Makes 4 servings.

GRILLED QUAIL

6 to 8 dressed quail
1 cup orange juice
1 cup white wine
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup olive oil

1 garlic clove
 $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon salt
 $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon pepper
Rosemary

Combine the quail, orange juice, wine, olive oil, garlic, salt, pepper and rosemary in a bowl or plastic zip-top bag. Marinate in the refrigerator for 2 hours. Heat the grill to hot. Drain the quail and grill for 3 minutes on each side. Do not overcook. Serve on green salad with balsamic vinaigrette dressing. *Makes 3 to 4 servings.*

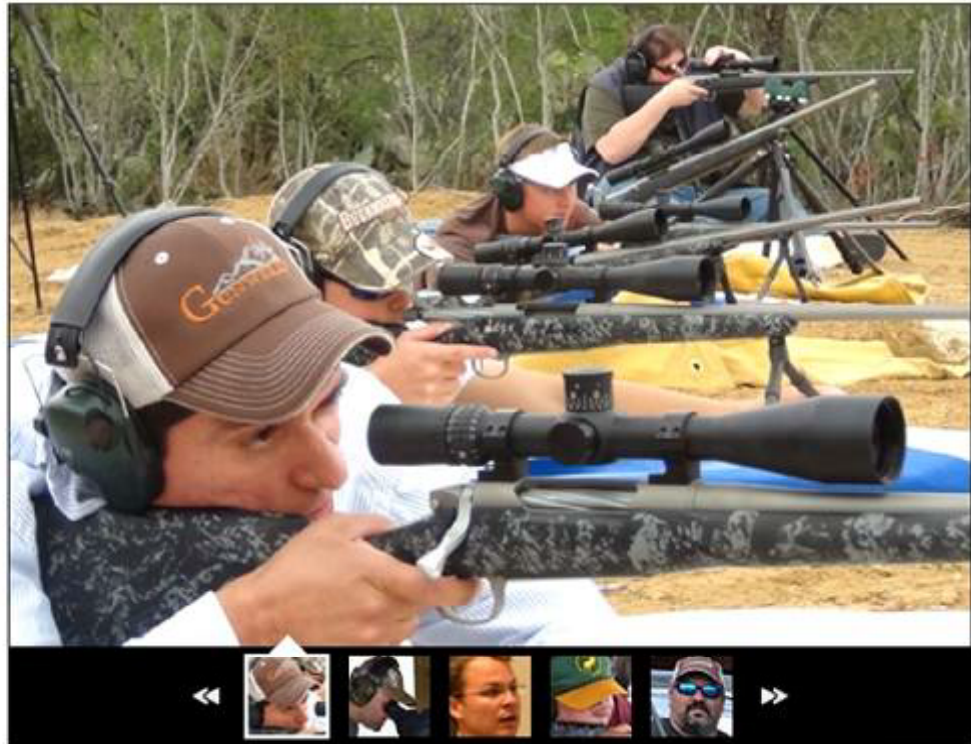

Black Bear Hunt and Fly-Fishing for Rainbows for 1 Hunter

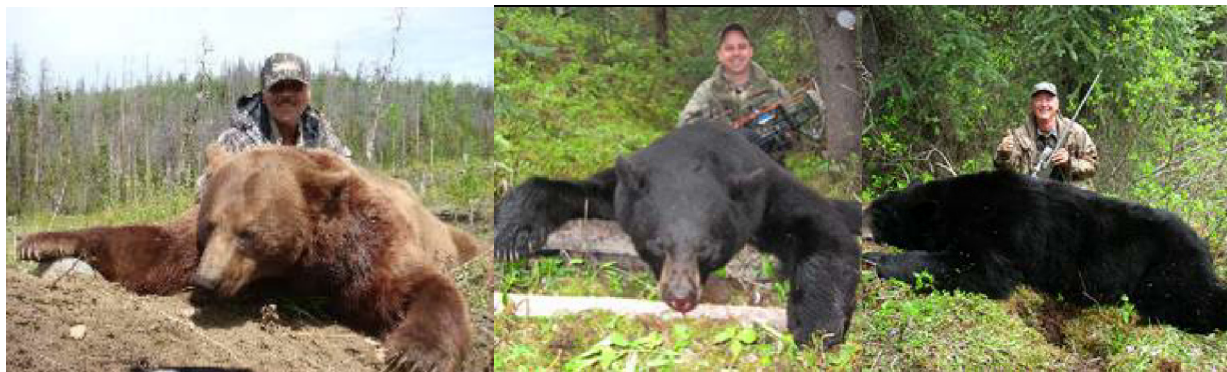
Our area has a very good reputation for large black bears - the one time Pope & Young record for the province was killed here. Our hunts are similar to the Vancouver Island black bear hunts, producing similar size bears with excellent coats due the colder winters. As licensed BC guides and outfitters, Fawnie Mountain Outfitters offer a variety of big game opportunities in the Chilcotin wilderness of British Columbia. Our bears come in a variety of colours - black, brown and blond, with black and brown as the most common.

Package Includes:

Value - \$6750

1. Black Bear hunt for 1 hunter
2. Winning bidder must bring at least 1 add'l hunter for \$4000 (a \$750 discount, paid directly to the outfitter)
3. Hunt is 2 hunters-1 guide
4. Transportation from Prince George to Hunting Lodge
5. Delivery of the hides to a local taxidermist, or will freeze them and the hunter may take them home after the hunt
6. Includes the floatplane flight from the bear camp to our fishing lodge at Moose Lake where you will relax and fish for Wild Native Rainbows after you have killed your bear

Dates for the hunt will be May 25-31 or June 1-7, could be 2012 or 2013 or 2014- depending on the buyers needs and outfitter's available dates. The hunt is for 1 bear each, and each hunter may shoot a second bear at a cost of \$1,000 per second bear killed, with no charge to hunt the second bear, a charge only if it is killed. Extra costs are licenses, \$350 for hunt license and first bear tag, \$175 for second bear tag. There is a 6% tax on all fees paid to Fawnie Mountain Outfitters, but not on the fees paid to SCI. 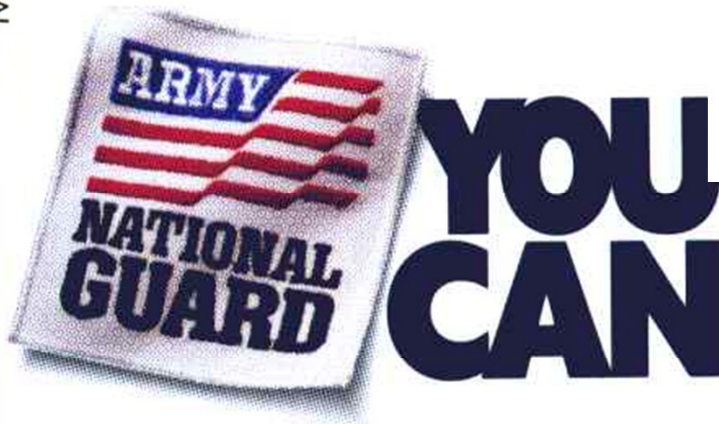

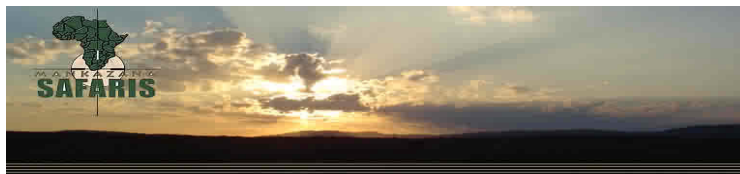

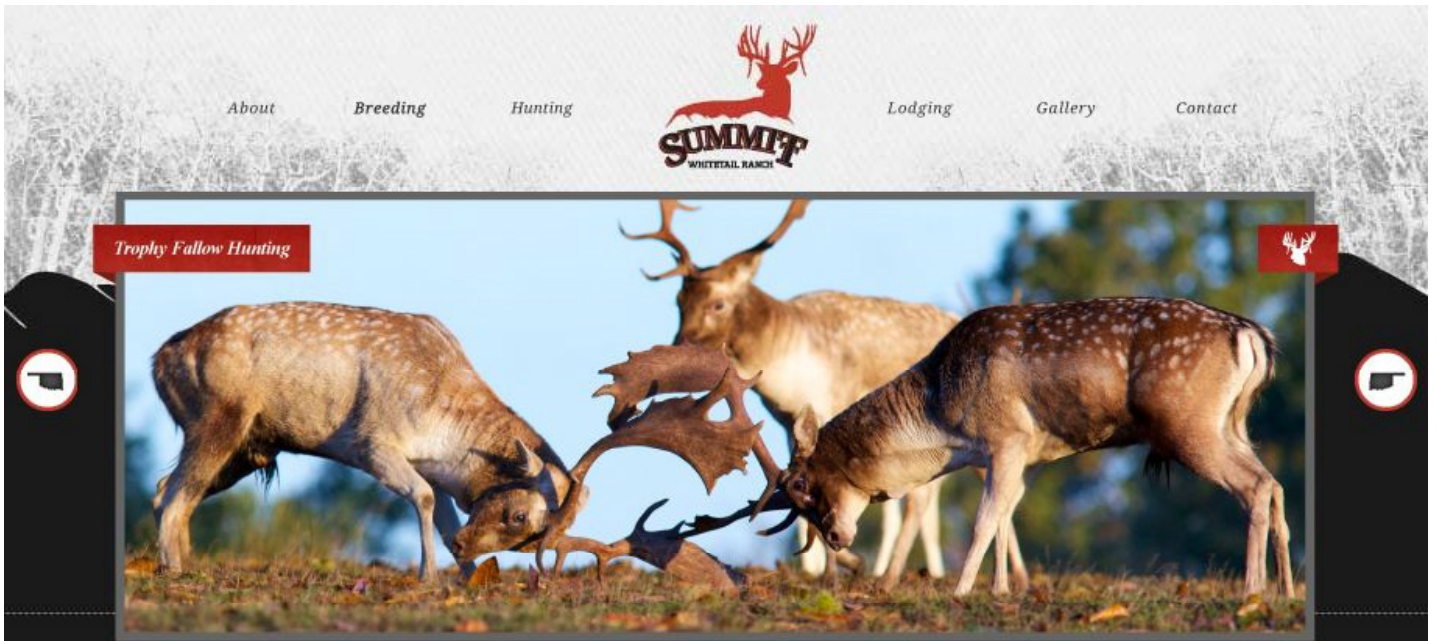

CRAB-STUFFED RAINBOW TROUT

1 tablespoon olive oil, plus additional for coating fish
1 tablespoon finely diced onion
1 tablespoon finely diced celery
2 tablespoons butter
1 cup crab meat (about 5 ounces)
1/4 cup Italian-seasoned bread crumbs
1/4 cup crushed saltine crackers
1 tablespoon lemon juice
1/4 teaspoon Old Bay seasoning
1/4 teaspoon pepper, plus additional for seasoning trout
5 or 6 wild rainbow trout, or 2 farm-raised rainbow trout,
about 1 1/2 pounds total, cleaned and left whole
Kosher salt and pepper

Prepare a grill for direct grilling over medium heat. Heat 1 tablespoon oil in a saucepan over medium heat and sauté the onion and celery for about 2 minutes. Add the butter, crab meat, bread crumbs, cracker crumbs, lemon juice and seasonings and mix gently but thoroughly.

Spoon stuffing into the cavity of each fish. Coat the fish all over with olive oil and place in a grilling basket. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Grill the fish, turning occasionally, for about 10 minutes, or until the fish are golden and flake easily. *Makes 2 servings.*

Trout abound in the mountain streams of North Carolina. Small to medium trout (8 to 14 inches) taste better than large ones.



SPICY VENISON AND BLACK OLIVE ROTINI

2 tablespoons extra-virgin olive
oil

1/2 cup chopped onion

2 garlic cloves, minced

1/8 to 1/4 teaspoon red pepper
flakes

1/2 pound ground venison

Scant 1/8 teaspoon cinnamon

Kosher salt and freshly ground
black pepper to taste

5 ounces rotini

1 (14-ounce) can diced tomatoes

1/4 teaspoon sugar

1/4 cup pitted black olives

1 tablespoon dried parsley

Grated Parmesan cheese

Heat the olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Sauté the onion until tender. Add the garlic and red pepper flakes. When the garlic is fragrant but not brown, add the venison and cinnamon. Season generously with salt and black pepper. Cook, breaking up the meat, until brown and crumbly.

Cook the pasta in boiling salted water according to the package directions.

Add the undrained tomatoes to the venison. Reduce heat to medium-low and cook for 8 to 10 minutes. Stir in the sugar, olives and parsley. Taste and add salt and pepper if needed.

Drain the rotini and add to the meat sauce and mix well. Serve immediately and top with additional parsley and Parmesan cheese. *Makes 2 to 3 servings.*
